The Metis Settlements are Metis communities who own and govern their own land base. We know that we descended from Metis ancestors. Metis people who are descendants of Metis ancestors and who are currently members of a contemporary Metis community have Metis aboriginal rights.

However, because of fairly recent supreme court of Canada rulings, the Government of Canada and Provincial Governments may require Metis organizations to substantiate or show evidence that we represent rights bearing Metis when entering into discussions and negotiations on aboriginal rights under Section 35 of the Constitution of Canada.

This is why it is very important for our Settlement members to have their family trees completed.

This genealogical evidence is needed to back up our claims to the government, and to the world, that we are Metis rights bearing communities.
